

Wilbur G. Benson

July 25, 1928 - August 5, 2015

Wilbur G. Benson, 87, of Mooresville, a lifelong volunteer firefighter and a founder of the Monroe Township Fire Department (Station 2 on Gasburg Road), passed from this life on Wednesday, August 5, 2015, in the comfort of his home. He was born on July 25, 1928, in Indianapolis, to the late Tom and Tressa "Dee" (Allee) Benson.

Wilbur was raised in West Newton and graduated from Decatur High School in 1947. He actively served in the United States Air Force, specializing in pilot assistance with navigating and controlling communications during the Korean and Vietnam War. He married the love of his life, Shirley Nauert on June 7, 1956. Wilbur worked at General Motors for 23 years; retiring in 1991. After retirement, he attended classes at IUPUI, where he became a certified electrician.

He was a lifelong member of IVFA and selflessly provided rescue services at Monroe Township Fire Department, established in 1975, on Gasburg Road, and additionally worked for Life Star & Life Line in Brown Township. He enjoyed reading and was the jack-of-all trades that liked to tinker in the garage and could rebuild almost anything. The joys in Wilbur's life was found at home, spending time with family, watching the grandkids grow up next door and traveling with Shirley.

Along with his parents, he was preceded in death by his daughter, Sandy Benson in 1979. Survivors include his loving wife, of nearly 60 years, Shirley M. (Nauert) Benson of Mooresville; adored daughter, Vickie Bryant (husband, Bill) of Mooresville; grandchildren, Megan Zeronik (husband, Brian) of Plainfield, Kelli Young (husband, Cameron) of Monrovia; Traci and Amber Bryant both of Mooresville; great grandchildren, Nolan, Anna, Lillian and Asher; brother-in-law, Dan Nauert of Mooresville.

A Celebration of Life Service will begin at 11am, on Saturday, August 8, 2015, at Light Memorial & Funeral Chapel in Monrovia. Visitation will be held at the funeral home on Friday, August 7, 2015, from 4 to 8pm, at 7pm, the Indiana Volunteer Firefighter's Association will conduct a memorial service. Wilbur will be carried on an antique fire engine in a firefighter's procession. Burial will be held at West Newton Cemetery, with military honors. 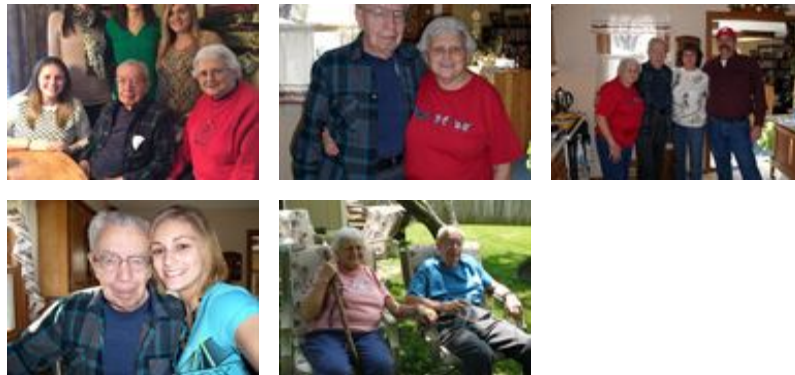
