William "Bill" L. Lloyd, 74, of Monrovia, passed peacefully from this life in the early morning hours of Friday, August 11, 2023, while in the comfort of his home. He was born in Bedford, IN on March 21, 1949, to the late Frank H. and Dorothy (Chastain) Lloyd.

A proud graduate with the class of 1968 at Manual High School, Bill secured employment with Indianapolis Power and Light, where he worked his way up the company ladder deservingly retiring in 2001 after 33 years of dedicated service. While working there, he met the love of his life and best friend, Louann. Enamored with her beauty, Bill would wait in a hallway until he could see her every day. Finally making the move to get her phone number, the two shared a brief courtship before vowing their never-ending love on September 1, 1979.

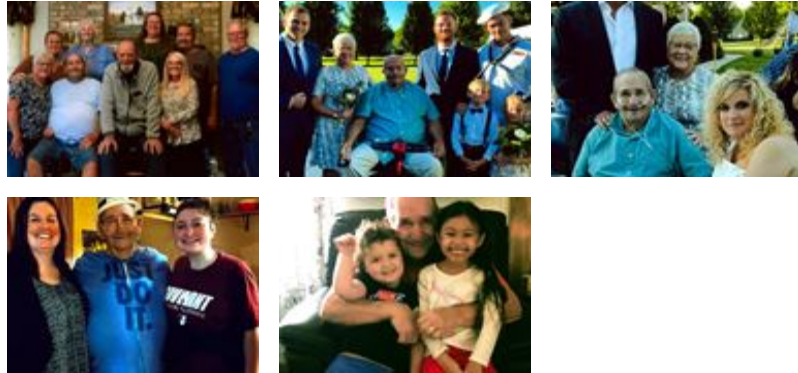
