



Zuzanna K. Foll

October 27, 1922 - November 12, 2015

Zuzanna K. "Granny" Foll, 93, of Martinsville, passed from this life at 2:50am, on Thursday, November 12, 2015, in the comfort of being surrounded by her loving family. She was born on October 27, 1922, in Czestochowa, Poland, to the late Ludwik and Marianna (Sokolowska) Knysak.

A Polish Catholic Martyr of the Holocaust, Zuzanna was fifteen years old when she was captured and placed in a concentration camp during the Nazi invasion of Poland. When World War II ended, she discontinued her studies to become a nun and married the love of her life, Stanislaw Bronislaw Foll. Zuzanna and her family left Europe in 1950, on the U.S.S. General Hann and came to the States; porting in Louisiana.

Zuzanna found work in the cafeteria at Jasper Memorial Hospital. She was a past member of the St. Joseph Catholic Church in Jasper, St. Clements Catholic Church in Booneville, the Madison Township Ladies Auxiliary and Mooresville Senior Center. An avid crafter, she enjoyed drawing, decorating, knitting, and sewing. She was notorious for making unique dolls, socks and bells. Full of spunk, Granny was not afraid to speak her mind and always told the truth. Mrs. Foll was a proud, determined, special woman and leaves her loved ones with an incredible legacy and life story that will be passed down through generations.

Along with her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Stanislaw Bronislaw Foll, to whom she was united in marriage on October 16, 1944; son, Zbigniew Stanislaw Foll; brother, Zygmunt Knysak; and sister, Wladystawa Galus.

Survivors include her loving daughter, Zdzislawa "Gigi" Barden (husband, Doug) of Martinsville; sons, Andrew Foll (wife, Connie) of Schnellville and Mark Foll (companion, Rosealita) of Birdseye; sister, Emilia Rousseau of Czestochowa, Poland; 14 grandchildren, many great grandchildren and great great grandchildren.

A celebration of life service will begin at 1pm, on Saturday, November 14, 2015, at Light Memorial & Funeral Chapel in Monrovia, with visitation held from 11am. Father John Hall will conduct a Rosary Prayer and Brother Rick Tankersley will officiate the service. Burial will follow in White Lick Cemetery, Mooresville.
